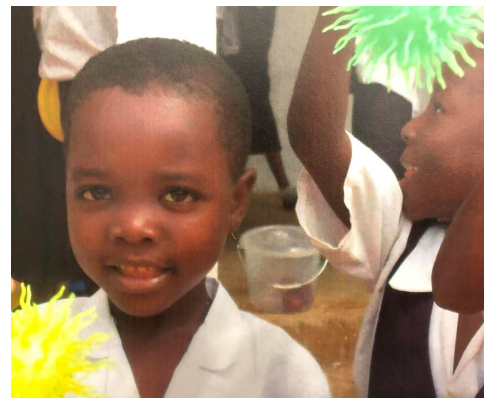

Jabez certainly met a need when we introduced the afterschool program. The number of children has grown from 26 in November to 41 by the end of December. Our biggest need at Jabez is for scholarship/grant money to help give a boost to the families who choose Jabez.

Our policy requires that families cover at least some of the costs of attending Jabez in order to have a personal investment in the education of their children. The Board has made it a policy to help families as we are able. We also want families and students to practice inter-dependency. Life works best when we give as able and receive as needed.

Another positive outcome from the afterschool program is that it is helping the youngest children attend school earlier in life. So often in Liberia the children start much later than would be advantageous due to finances. Many children who have started later feel self-conscious and tend to leave school in later elementary/junior high because the difference in age becomes more noticeable. This difficulty can disappear when the children start while young.
